



**MC3 Geneva G. Brier**

Mass Communication Specialist 3rd Class Geneva G. Brier entered the United States Navy from Las Vegas, Nevada at age 24. She completed Recruit Training at Great Lakes, Ill., in 2010 as a seaman. She then attended Mass Communication Specialist “A” School at Fort Meade, Maryland’s Defense Information School. After six months of training she graduated and was assigned to Naval Special Warfare Command (NAVSPECWARCOM) located on Naval Amphibious Base in Coronado, Calif. Six months later she advanced to Petty Officer 3rd Class.

Early in her tenure at NAVSPECWARCOM, Brier was hand-selected to brief the NSW Commander and his Echelon II staff department heads on the daily articles of interest during the commander’s update brief.
