Chief Mass Communication Specialist Dale Davis, a native of Gregory, Texas, and enlisted in the Navy in November 1995. Following basic training at Recruit Training Command, Great Lakes, Ill., he reported to Photographer's Mate 'A' School at Naval Air Station, Pensacola, Fla.

Upon completion of initial training, he reported aboard USS Independence (CV 62) in Yokosuka, Japan, where he served as a quality control technician in the ship's Intelligence Center Photo Lab. Following Independence's decommissioning, he returned to Yokosuka aboard USS Kitty Hawk (CV 63) serving as production supervisor in the ship's photo lab. PH2 Davis then reported to the Regional Visual Information Support Center at Naval Station Roosevelt Roads, Puerto Rico. He then reported to Fleet Intelligence Training Center in San Diego, Calif. where he served lead instructor for the Intelligence Photography Course. During this tour he was named Naval Intelligence Instructor of the Year for 2004. PH1 Davis returned to Japan to serve as the Media Services Leading Petty Officer onboard USS Blue Ridge (LCC 19). It was during this tour that he was selected for promotion to Chief Petty Officer.
