Public Affairs Officer, USS Nimitz (CVN 68)

As a Public Affairs Officer for USS Nimitz (CVN 68) and Carrier Strike Group 11 (CSG 11) Lt. Jason Scarborough serves as the Media Department head, spokesman for USS Nimitz, and provides strategic communication counsel to CSG 11. He is currently serving as USS Nimitz (CVN 68) Media Department Division Officer.

Lt. Scarborough has served as a public affairs action officer and deputy director of the Navy Visual News Service for the Chief of Naval Information, Washington, D.C. from 2008 to 2010. He has 11 years of prior enlisted service and received his commission through Officer Candidate School in 2008. From 2003 to 2007, he served as an Instructor and Course Developer at the Defense Information School, Ft. Meade, Md. where he earned his Master Training Specialist qualification.

Scarborough has also attended the Army Airborne Course, Ft. Benning, GA, the Military Photojournalism course at Syracuse University, Syracuse, NY, and both PH "A" and "C" schools through the Defense Information School. Scarborough has served at NAS Oceana, Virginia Beach, VA, and as a Photographers Mate on board USS Theodore Roosevelt (CVN 71) from 1998 to 2002. Scarborough entered the Navy in 1997 at RTC, Great Lakes, IL.

Lieutenant Scarborough is married to Christine Scarborough and father to Nicholas, Paris, Dylan and Elliot. His decorations and awards include the Joint Service Commendation Medal, Joint Service Achievement Medal (3 awards), Navy Marine Corps Achievement Medal (2 awards), and various other unit and campaign awards.
