Mass Communication Specialist 2nd Class Jerine Lee is a graphic illustrator at Commander, Joint Intelligence Operations Center, a unit assigned to U.S. Pacific Command in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii.

Born in Bowling Green, Ohio, Lee grew up in Sylvania, Ohio and earned her high school diploma from Sylvania Southview High School in June 2008 and was an active member of the school's newspaper as the photography editor and school yearbook committee as the photography editor and layout director.

Lee entered the Navy in July 2008. After completing basic recruit training in Great Lakes, Ill., she attended the Defense Information School for her "A" school in Fort Meade, Md., and graduated on April 2009.

Her first duty station was to the USS ABRAHAM LINCOLN (CVN 72), home ported in Everett, Wash. She did two deployments aboard the Lincoln, including the "around-the-world" tour, changing homeports to Norfolk, Va.

She began her duties on the Lincoln as a team photojournalist in the command's media department and through motivation and hard work, moved up to hold the duties of the editor of the command newspaper, "The Penny Press," which earned 1st place in the Tabloid Newspaper category in the CHINFO Merit Awards in 2010 and then later held duties of the department's production supervisor and was announced the Junior Sailor of the Quarter of 1st Quarter of Fiscal year 2012 for her performance.

Lee returned to DINFOS from October to December 2012 to earn her 8193 NEC and began her duties at PACOM JIOC.

At the Joint Intelligence Operations Center, Lee participates in various bilateral and trilateral military-to-military training exercises, providing graphic support to intelligence community components, allies and partners. His command collateral duties include the Public Affairs Officer of the Joint Service Organization's Holiday Party Committee, Events Coordinator of the Second Class Mess, Events Coordinator of the Coalition of Sailors Against Destructive Decisions (CSADD), Multicultural Committee and the backup MIB illustrator.

Petty Officer Lee's personal awards include a Joint Service Achievement Medal, Navy Achievement Medals and service awards
